The enclosed map shows the route to the Anderson's from Walpole (intersection of routes 27 and 1A.) The best routes to Walpole are as follows:.

FROM NEW HAMPSHIRE, MAINE & BOSTON AREA

Follow Route 128 to Route 109 (Exit 59W). Follow Route 109 (West), through Westwood, to North Street-about 5 miles from Route 128 (on your left at the Bubbling Brook Ice Cream Stand, which is closed for the winter.) Take the left (North Street which becomes Fisher Street) for about 4 miles until you come to Route 1A and then follow the map.

FROM RHODE ISLAND AND SOUTHEASTERN CONN.

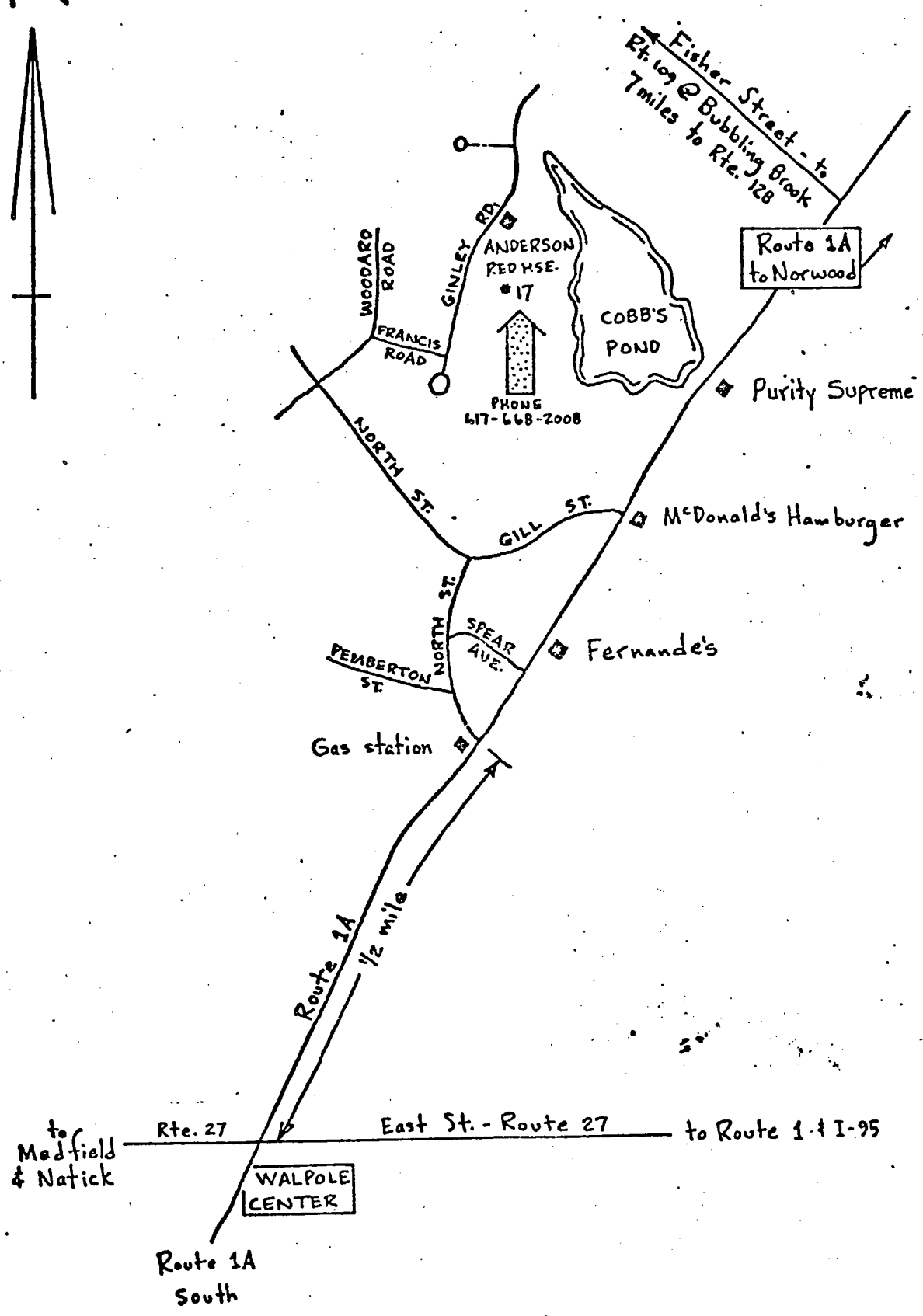
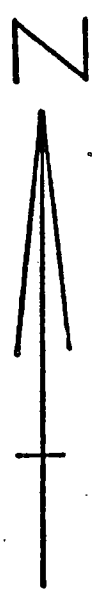
Follow I-95 (North) to the Exit ramp to Route 27, which takes you into Walpole.

FROM WORCESTER, KEENE, & HARTFORD

Follow I-495 (South) to Route 109, near Milford, Mass., follow Route 109 (East) to Route 27 in Medfield, and then Route 27 (South) to Walpole and then follow the map.

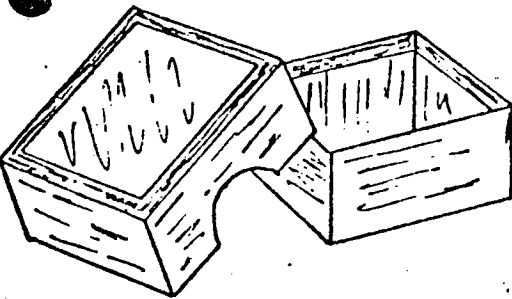

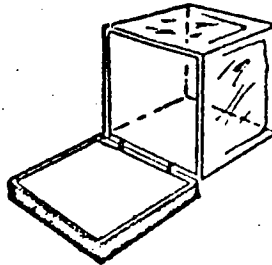

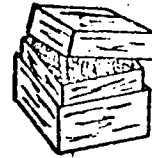
