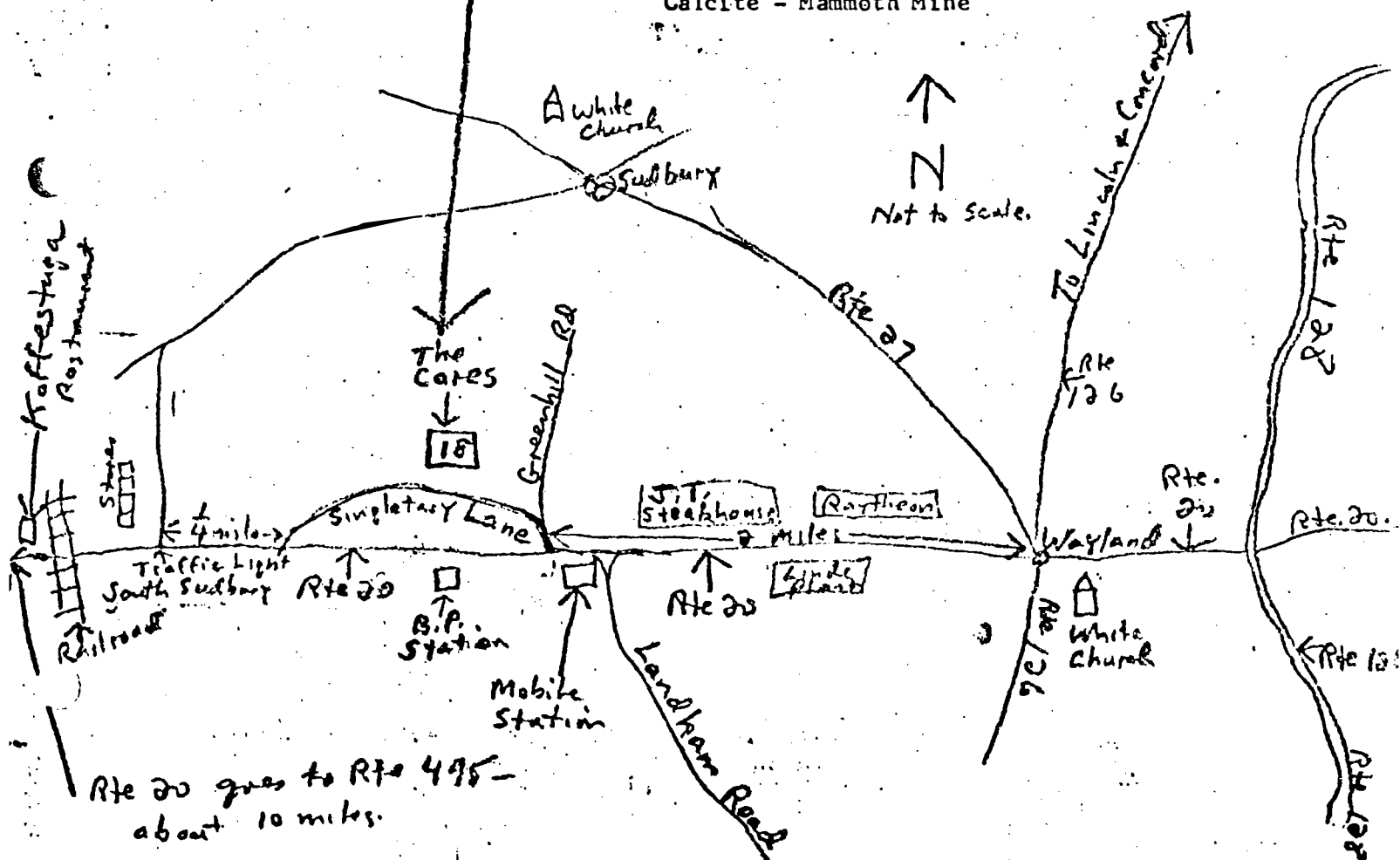


ACCESS TO DEMIX QUARRIES

MONT ST-HILAIRE

By the present we wish to inform all previous visitors of the regulations now applying to this coming summers' field trips to the quarry. We feel the present proposal is the best that we can offer to persons interested in collecting minerals on the grounds of DEMIX LTD, Mont St-Hilaire, Québec.

(1) The quarry must operate on Saturdays all day, therefore no more visits will be allowed on this day. (2) Visits will be possible on SUNDAYS only, after communicating with the undersigned. (3) In all the mines and quarries operated in the Province of Quebec, it is compulsory to wear a hard hat, goggles and proper shoes. Visitors must comply to this obligation. (4) Visiting hours on Sundays will be restricted to 9 A.M. until 4 P.M. upon reservation. (5) The fee is still \$ 25.00 for each group. (6) Upon registering at the gate you will be asked to prove that your group is covered by an insurance civil liability policy of at least \$ 500,000.00 applying to both people and property and to sign a document attesting this fact.

In order to facilitate planification of all visits, we ask all those interested in collecting at the quarry to make the reservations via postal service as soon as possible.
